time and that the directors devoted their energy to the things which, in their opinion, were most urgent. It was also felt that advantage should be taken of opportunities that presented. As exemple, when the Canadian Tuberculosis Association and the Canadian Public Health Association met here during the year, a good deal of time and energy was devoted to assisting them, because of the etimulus and educational value such meetings bring to health work in the community where they are held.

The success of health work will depend upon united efforts.

For that reason, the Health League, in everything which it has touched, has tried to work along with others so that the effort would influence and interest a larger group and bring about, in quicker time, the results desired.

Bo person and no organization can claim that progress is the result of his or their effort. If this year is seeing definite progress in health work, the larger part of it is the result of the work of years gone by: some of it may perhaps be due to the extra push which the Health League may have been able to give, and that is all a year's work can expect to produce in a field of work that will require not weeks or months, but years to show results.
