THE BOOK OF CONSTITUTION OF

Grand Master or Deputy Grand Master, and to take to him any books and papers he may direct; to conduct the correspondence of the Grand Lodge; to receive regularly, credit and record, all monies of the Grand Lodge, and pay over the same without delay to the Grand Treasurer, and annually report the amount received, and the source whence received; and generally to do all such things as have been done, or ought to have been done by a Grand Secretary; for which service he shall receive out of the funds of the Grand Lodge a sum not less than one hundred dollars annually.

CHAPTER VII.

OF GRAND CLERK.

SECTION 1. The Grand Clerk shall be Elected and Invested at the Annual Communication.

SECTION 2. He shall assist the Grand Secretary and in his absence perform his duties.

CHAPTER VIII.

OF GRAND CHAPLAIN.

SECTION 1. The Grand Chaplain shall be Elected and Invested at the Annual Communication.
