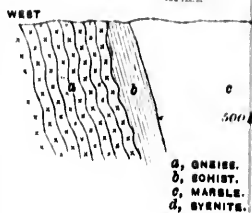

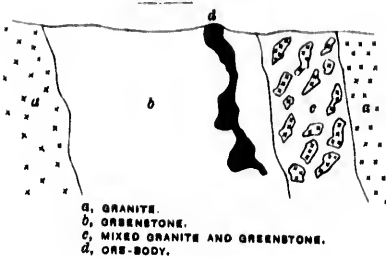
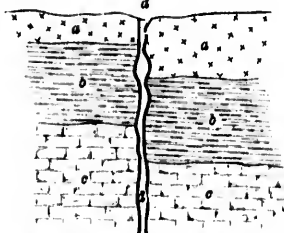
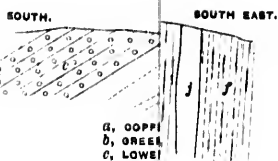


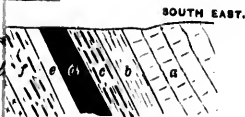

SECTION OF A VERTICAL FAULT.

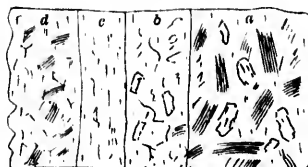
