While this could not be confirmed, it was regarded as quite likely, and in line with incessual preparations pursued in case of emergency. Another rumor was that Senator Proctor was shot in Havana. There was no aggressive support, and under influence of renewed liquidation and local traders putting out fresh short lines, the market developed a weak undertone and declined. London houses traded on both sides, selling New York Central and St. Paul and buying Northern Pacific and Union Pacific. The favorable factors and the situation had no influence. The indications are that, pendulg new developments in Cuban situation, the market will continue duil and professional. Near the close there was a sharp fractional raily on covering of shorts by room traders, and early sellers, but final prices, except in one or two instances, showed only slight recovery from lowest quotations.
