Pope's Wonderful Vitality Bears Him Up Successful Operation Followed by Restless Sleep Cardinal Gotti Alone With the Pontiff

All Signs Point to the Passing
of the Aged Patient in a
Few Hours.

BULLETIN.

8.15 a.m.—Pope Leo is now in a
troubled sleep.

9.25 a.m.—It is hoped that the Pope's
strength will be maintained, as he
has taken somewhat more nourish-
ment, especially from the yolk
of an egg with small sips of a
stimulant, especially brandy.

8.30 p.m.—The condition of the Pope
continues sufficiently satisfactory.
His circulation and breathing are
slow, but they are gradually im-
proving.

9 p.m.—After the operation Dr. Maz-
zoni said the danger remained im-
minent, but the illness from which
the Pope was suffering was full of
surprises. His Holiness might even
live three days longer.

8.45 p.m.—The test puncture of the
pleura has been made and eight
hundred grams of liquid have been
taken off. A rapid examination
showed that some mucus was re-
taining in the lung which was origi-
nally affected. The Pope underwent
the operation with courage. His
general condition is now better,
and he is resting.

POPE NOW SLEEPING.

Rome, July 8, 3.45 a.m.—Pope Leo is
now sleeping, but his head lies un-
easy on the pillow. The alleviation
of the operation was followed by
about by yesterday's operation of mov-
ing the fluid from his pleura was
retained later in the evening by a restless
period and fresh doses of chloral, digi-
tals and caffeine had to be adminis-
tered. Under these influences the Pon-
tiff fell into a slumber which, however,
was not very peaceful on account of
the difficulty the patient has in breath-
ing.

side, the Pope just before falling asleep
said kindly to him: "NOW IT IS
YOUR TURN TO-NIGHT, YOU MUST
SLEEP."

Through the Vatican absolute calm
prevails tonight, the excitement of yester-
day having to a great extent died
out with the revival of hope after the
announcement that yesterday's opera-
tion was attended with success.

MUCH SIGNIFICANCE IS ATTACH-
ED TO AN EXTENDED VISIT MADE
BY CARDINAL GOTTI, PREFECT OF
THE PROPAGANDA TO THE SICK
ROOM, FROM WHICH OUR CORRESPONDENT
RECEIVED THE FOLLOWING REPORT:

Just what passed between the Pon-
tiff and Cardinal Gotti only they know,
but certainly the visit was of great im-
portance. The Pope's condition, as

attention to the point of death and the
affairs of the church when he himself
has passed away.

POPE'S VITALITY.

With Fortitude He Withstood the
Operation, and Even Sleep.

Rome, July 7.—The marvelous vi-
tality and recuperative energy of the
Pope were never so forcibly demon-
strated as by the series of events pre-
ceding, accompanying and following to-
day's operation.

Turning to Dr. Lapponi, this morn-
ing he asked: "Will it be painful?
Remember I can not stand much
pain."

Instead of Dr. Lapponi, Dr. Mazzoni
answered: "I can assure you, His Holiness
that you will feel no pain."

The Pope then concluded: "Then
do whatever you think best."

When the operation took place no-
body was allowed in the room beside
the doctors, except Pope Leo's valet
Cattolico, even his nephew, Count de
Gregori, left the room.

It was thought desirable that the
Pope should receive his last communion,
as soon as this was proposed, the Pope
himself made a movement, showing
again his spirit of activity and deter-
mination.

Dr. Mazzoni, however, took him in
his arms. Pope Leo smiled and ex-
claimed: "Bravo, professor, I con-
gratulate you. Although I have become
so light, I must still be rather heavy."

Pope Leo remained resting in the
during the whole time of the opera-
tion without need of support. The
Pope went through the whole affair with
out showing any feeling of pain. He
was extremely pale, almost daphnoid,
and the operation was very successful.
Dr. Mazzoni at once administered a cordial.

The Pope afterwards received a de-
cided rest. The liquid which was re-
moved from his thorax, the Pon-
tiff then asked for medical explana-
tion of the apparatus used in the
operation. "It is a most ingenious
instrument," he said, "but your hand
is also very clever. That is why the
operation was successful in not giving
me any pain. I thank you."

After half an hour of peaceful and
apparently refreshing repose, the Pope
awoke and inquired about the doc-
tors. Hearing they were busy, he then
went to bed. He said: "I thought they
had gone. What do they stay here
for? What are they plotting?"

Dr. Lapponi, returning to the room
said: "We were preparing bulletins
regarding the operation, saying it was
successful in all respects."

"Very well," replied His Holiness,
"I wish to see myself these bulletins
in exact text."

He then went on speaking about the
causes of his illness, "I would like
to know," he said, "from what it
comes. I think I have always follow-
ed Dr. Lapponi's advice."

"Not always," replied His Holiness, "re-

of suction slowly drew it off. Under
the skilful guidance of Dr. Mazzoni the
operation scarcely occupied over four
minutes.

The Pope manifested no pain what-
ever, neither was there the slightest
quiver from mental dread of the opera-
tion. In the language of one of the
doctors the cocaine so d-dened the
parts that the Pontiff felt no more than
a slight pin prick. As soon as the li-
quid was drawn off by the suction
needle the patient felt great relief, ow-
ing to the removal of the pressure of
the liquid on the lung and simultane-
ously the doctors could hear air pass-
ing thru that zone which this morning
was declared to be imperious, owing
to congestion. From a pathological
standpoint the free passage of air was
considered satisfactory, but, far more
