TARTE RE MONK INCIDENT.

Is But a Common in Great Political Book Now Being Written.

Montreal, Feb. 21. (Special.)—Speaking of the La Presse in making over the Monk incident, La Presse says: "It is a secret for no one that La Presse since 1900 has been the personal and principal organ of Sir Wilfrid Laurier. It is more, it is the organ of Hon. Mr. Prefontaine in political as well as municipal affairs. It is, therefore, quite in order that it should secure as much capital as possible for the government out of the incident. It does not seem to us to blame or to oppose Mr. Monk's action, as he is making a big own conduct. We know that for some time past he has complained of almost everyone in his own party. Whether he is right or wrong, it is not for our custom to meddle with other people's business."

La Presse thinks it is doing a clever act in making Mr. Tarte's name in this matter. The ministerial party has just received a serious blow. It is threatened, in fact, in its strongest position. The big Thibetan force assembled at Gurn has dwindled to 2000 men, and there is nothing to indicate what will be the next phase in the event of the dalai lama maintaining his present attitude.

The Indian government has taken the greatest pains to emphasize the fact that the mission entirely is political, and its sole object the amicable settlement of outstanding difficulties with the lama government. It lays stress on the fact that Col. Younghusband has the most careful instructions not to excite hostility, while Gen. Macdonald has been ordered to act on the defensive only, his sole duty being to safeguard the commissioners. His force unquestionably is stronger than is necessary for that purpose, and sufficient to make his way to Lhasa, where his presence would give Col. Younghusband a strong "argument" in dealing with the lama.

Russia's Six Move. The Indian government claims to have possession of documents constituting an invalid treaty signed by the czar and the lama's government eighteen months ago, when the concessions were made to Russia so extensive and so exclusive as practically to give the development of Thibet entirely into the hands of Russia.

Russia has formally denied the existence of this treaty, but Russian delegates carry little weight, especially when Thibetans do not deny it, and their intercourse with the British commissioners at Khamshang they made no secret of the support they actually were receiving and upon which they relied in the event of the outbreak.
