League President Granted Leave of Absence—Umpire Scandal Laid Over.

CHICAGO, Feb. 18.—Factional strife in the National League was removed at the closing session of the managers to-day, when President Harry C. Pulliam was granted an indefinite leave of absence.

In handling the problem of tickets, the managers brought out to the players by adopting a rule that no passes be issued to the latter, either to the home grounds or while they are in other cities.

When the National commission holds its meeting it is thought that the request of President Murphy to be permitted to pay a \$10,000 bonus to his players, as per the promise he made before the close of the last season's championship series, will be considered.
