

**Mr. Speaker:** Order, please. My distinct recollection is that while I was reading the motion—

**Mr. Coates:** The second time! He has been out twice!

**Mr. Speaker:** This is the first time I have been aware that the hon. member or any other hon. member has entered or left the Chamber twice. I am prepared to hear points of order.

The hon. member raised a question of privilege and asked me what was involved in the taking of a vote. And I answered him. I have not heard any objection that the vote is wrong up to this point. If there is one, I am prepared to hear it.

**Mr. Coates:** Mr. Speaker, during the time of the taking of the last vote the hon. member for Comox-Alberni got up and walked out of the Chamber before the vote was completed. That was why I asked to know whether or not the hon. member's vote was counted having regard to the fact he was not in the Chamber at the time the vote was completed.

It had nothing to do with the subject of my original question of privilege which was the fact that the hon. member did not wait until the vote was completed before walking out of the Chamber. I asked you, Sir, whether his vote was counted and whether the vote which the Clerk indicated was the vote was in fact the vote.

**Mr. Speaker:** Of course if the hon. member puts it to me in that way—and I cannot verify it from the Chair—if there is no argument or discussion to the contrary—

**Some hon. Members:** Ask him!

**Mr. Speaker:** If there is nothing said to the contrary I have to accept the hon. member's statement. I will therefore ask the Clerk whether the vote of the hon. member for Comox-Alberni was registered in the division on the last motion.

The count shows that those voting against the motion included the hon. member for Comox-Alberni. The undisputed information I have is that before the vote was properly announced the hon. member for Comox-Alberni left the Chamber. The record will have to show that the hon. member for Comox-Alberni was not correctly recorded in the vote.

**Some hon. Members:** Hear, hear!

The question now before the House is upon motion No. 11 in the name of the hon. member for Nickel Belt (Mr. Rodriguez).
