WAS BORN HERE

Dr. R. Withers Had a Notable Career-Was Prominent in Sport.

The whole town and countryside were grieved to learn of the death of Dr. Russell Withers, which occurred about noon on Sunday, Jan. 29, and although he had considerably exceeded the fourscore marks, was always so active and such a cheery, familiar figure about town that he will be sincerely missed.

practicing physicians in Nova Scotia, and had enjoyed quite an eventful career before settling down in Annapolis Royal, which he did forty-five years ago, and as ever since been a prominent citizen e was born in St. John, N. B., on Feb was born in St. John, N. B., on Feb-iary 22, 1836, the anniversary of Wash-ington's birthday, which often led him to remark that he should have been an American. Indeed his long residence in the United States gave him an affection for the republic which he never sought to eradicate and to the day of his death he was an active member of St. John's Lodge, No. 1, A. F. and A. M. of New Lodge, No. I, A. F. and A. M. of New York City, a membership which was fully appreciated by the lodge, from which he was the receipient of cards of remembrance every Christmas and two years ago of a handsome Masonic pin. This being the oldest Masonic lodge in the United States, he was naturally proud of the membership and refused to demit to the local lodge.


