### ROBS HOUSES WHILE MOURNERS ARE AT GRAVE

New York, May 2.—Joseph Harris, thirty-eight years old, of 156 Christie street, was held in \$5,000 bail before the magistrate William A. Sweetser in the Yorkville court on a burglary charge. Detective Sergeant Vincent Durning of the Sixty-seventh street station told the magistrate that Harris, who has had a dozen police aliases, was arrested after he had robbed the home of Aaron Deutsch on the ground floor of 228 East Eighty-second street. Deutsch and other members of his family were attending the funeral of Deutsch's wife. The detective added that the couple had moved from the house a few minutes before Harris jammed the door and gathered up two gold watches and other articles of jewelry.

Miss Elizabeth Fisher, nineteen years old, of 426 East Seventy-ninth street, discovered the man in the dining room when she went there to arrange the apartment before the return of the family from the cemetery.

"Good morning," she quoted Harris as saying to her when he entered the kitchen door. "I'm the undertaker. I'm just arranging things."

"You are not the undertaker," Miss Fisher replied, "you're a thief."

Harris then grabbed up the Jimmy and bolted through a front window to the sidewalk, Miss Fisher said. The detective was standing at the corner of Second avenue and Eighty-first street when he saw Harris, followed by Miss Fisher, making for the Second avenue elevated station at Eighty-first street. The detective captured him as he was about to board a train.
