 Buctouche in the County of Kent, and Province  
 of New Brunswick. For and in consideration of the  
 sum of twenty five pounds currency of New  
 Brunswick to us in hand, well and truly paid  
 by Samuel Allain of Buctouche aforesaid. The  
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have granted  
 bargained and sold and by these Presents do  
 grant bargain and sell unto the said Samuel  
 Allain, one certain piece of land situate in the  
 Indian Reserve on the north side of the Big Bush  
 River in the Parish of Wellington, and bounded as  
 follows, upon the south by the River on the West by  
 lands now in the possession of Schumath Beckwith  
 on the North by the Main Road leading up the North  
 side said Buctouche River and upon the East by  
 a part of said Indians Reserve and to measure  
 in width or front from East to West as many rods  
 as to contain between the Main River and Main  
 Road fifty acres and no more. To Have and To  
 Hold all our right title interest property claims  
 or demands into or out of the land described, with  
 all improvements belonging thereto, unto the before  
 named
