CONSTITUTION OF THE CONTINGENT FUND.

NAME.

1. This Fund shall be called the Contingent Fund of the Hamilton Conference of the Methodist Church.

OBJECT.

2. The objects of this Fund shall be: 1st. To pay all contingent expenses in connection with the working of Conference committees. 2nd. To relieve cases of special affliction, and defray extraordinary expenses incurred in the service of the Church. All applications for expenses incurred in the general work, or for claims not otherwise specified, shall be submitted to the Committee in detail for their investigation and approval.

Sources of Income.

3. The sources of income shall be: 1st. A collection to be taken up on all the circuits in the month of March in each year. 2nd. The public collections taken up at each Annual Conference. 3rd. Such amount as may be appropriated by the Billeting Fund Committee.
