take care of herself and leave the rest of the Empire to do the same, are placing a stumbling block in the way of the movement. If it was believed that this was a step in the direction of separation the policy would be condemned. There is not among the people of Canada any such aspiration. Canadians were never more firmly resolved to remain with the Empire than they are now. If the Canadian navy programme cannot be justified as a means of strengthening the whole Empire, and of holding it together, it cannot be justified at all. If it is taught that the proposed navy is the beginning of a scheme of pulling the Empire apart, and that doctrine is accepted, the scheme and its promoters will go to swift destruction together. It may be true that Canada is destined to be strong enough to face the world alone, but it does not follow that she Intends, when that time comes, to leave the rest of the Empire to face
