MURDER WORSHIP.

Anarchists of New York Cheer Bresci's Name. Speakers at the Meeting Say They Deserve a Fate Similar to Humbert--President McKinley Condemned in Public.

Sydney, Aug. 16-(Special)-After a delightful sail through picturesque Bras d'Or Lakes, Premier Laurier and party arrived at Sydney at 10:30 o'clock tonight.

Little preliminary notice of the meeting had been given outside the anarchist circles, but more than 500 anarchists were in attendance.

The speaker was the first to speak. He was in the body of the hall he shouted: "Name of Bresci; shall we cheer it."

The answer was a roar of approval that lasted for several minutes. Huffizi then mounted the rostrum, and in a fiery speech rehearsed the social conditions of Italy, which he said, and I believe, are the cause of the killing of Humbert. Riers of other countries came in for condemnation, and were denounced as meriting a similar fate.

Pedro Esteve, speaking in Spanish and in English, followed in a similar vein. Other speakers followed, and President McKinley came in for a sharp condemnation.

The reading of articles to make war, was more unprofitable than the one of Bresci, the anarchist. The speech, Kaiser Wilhelm at Bremerhaven was also more to be condemned than the wild utterances of anarchist idealists.
