





A plain cloth dipped in hot water and then in a saucer of bran will clean white paint and not injure it. The bran acts like soap on the paint. When mapkins or tablecloths become worn they may be utilized for bibs or soft towels for the baby. When made into bibs it is well to make them double. To clean and tighten cane seats, soak them well in hot water and use soap if it is needed. Then dry in the open air.
