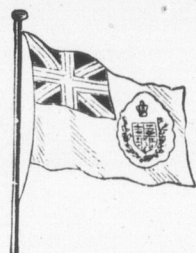

## Our Book Department

*Sons of Africa*—by Georgina Gol-  
lock (Friendship Press \$1.50).

This is a series of biographical  
sketches of eminent Africans. The  
lives of these men and women are  
a revelation of the depth and the  
strength of character of people of  
whom the world knows far too lit-  
tle.

*Portraits in Color*—Mary White  
Ovington (Viking Press \$2.00)

Do you know what the Negroes  
of to-day have done? You prob-  
ably know what other Negroes say  
of them. Here is what one of the  
white folks has to say about them.

Miss Ovington is Chairman of the  
Board of the NAACP. She has  
spent 25 years in work among col-  
ored people. In this book she giv-  
es sketches of 20 of the leading men  
and women of to-day in our race.  
These are all people whom she  
knows personally, and with whom  
she has worked. The book is ac-  
curate, concise and yet brimful of  
drama.

*For Freedom*—Arthur Fauset.

A biographical story of the Am-  
erican Negro—of his racial heroes,  
who are yet National heroes, rather  
than racial: of the New Negro, the  
cultured man, his hopes, his strug-  
gles, his aspirations, his accom-  
plishments, his abiding faith in the  
future.

*The Pedro Gorina*—Capt. Harry  
Dean. Capt. Dean is an American  
Negro, descended from a line of Af-  
rican Kings. He is a sea captain  
a master mariner whose life ambi-  
tion has been to found an Ethiop-  
ian Empire in Africa. With the  
assistance of Sterling North, he has  
written the account of his advent-  
ures in following this ambition on  
land and sea. In his dreams he re-  
stored the grandeur of Ethiopia; he  
built cities in the African jungles;  
the sons of the Phoenicians once  
more attained their genius and their  
ships sailed on every sea.

He failed to accomplish his desire  
being finally run out of Africa by  
the English, but the very fact that  
he tried hard enough to attract their  
attention makes his story worth our  
reading. The tale is well told and  
his publishers vouch for its truth.
