
Company's Well-Repairs Being

The city this morning enjoyed the unusual experience of a water famine, notwithstanding the presence of a river skirting its western boundary and another on the south. At half past 10 customers of the water company who had occasion to turn on their taps were a little discomfitted at perceiving only a rush of air gush forth instead of the usual copious flow of aqua pura. The reason was soon ascertained to be the scarcity of water in the well at the water works. Since the construction of the well a year ago last spring it has been observed that in the fall and spring there is always a very perceptible dimunition in the water supply which does not occur either in mid-summer or mid-winter. The well is 34 feet deep, cribbed to the bottom with 8x8 timbers and usually contains from 12 to 14 feet of water constantly. The difficulty this morning was not observed until it was noticed the pump was hoisting air instead of water. An investigation showed but three feet of water in the well and the suction pipe was too short to be of any further service. 
