MILITIA AND DEFENCE :

1. Bill to consolidate and amend the Laws affecting the Militia of Canada (Mr. Caron); Ordered; Presented, 53. Read second time; Committed, Progress reported, 197, 204. Bill amended; Reported; Motion for consideration; Amendment moved by Mr. Ross (*Middlesex*) that the Bill be re-committed, so as to provide that nothing in Regulations and Orders so far as they relate to the establishment of Canteens shall render lawful the sale of beer or malt liquors of any kind whatsoever; Debate thereon adjourned, 228. Resumed; Amendment withdrawn; Bill, as amended, considered; Motion for third reading; Amendment moved by Mr. Ross (*Middlesex*), to re-commit the Bill for the purpose of omitting the provisions for the proposed enlistment of a third Battery of Artillery, a Troop of Cavalry and three Companies of Infantry, 264. Negatived; Bill read third time and passed; Title to be "An Act consolidating and amending the several Acts relating to the Militia and Defence of the Dominion of Canada," 265. By the Senate, with an amendment, 351; Considered; Agreed to, 364. R. A., 440. (46 Vic., c. 11).
