

uses and purposes, any goods, chattels, gifts, or benefactions whatsoever; and also to sell and convey the same or any part thereof in as ample and full a manner, and by the same
 5 authority as is above mentioned with regard to real property (also subject to the provisions hereinafter in that behalf contained,) and shall and may by the said name of "*The Hamilton and Gore Mechanics' Institute,*" be
 10 able and capable to sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto in all Courts of Law or Equity and places whatsoever in all and singular actions, causes, pleas, suits, matters and de-
 15 mands whatsoever, in as large, ample and beneficial a manner and form as any other body politic or corporate, or any persons able and capable in law may or can sue or be sued, impleaded or answered in any man-
 20 ner whatsoever; and shall also by the said name take all conveyances and assurances of whatever description; and by the same name convey, assure, lease, or part with real, personal or mixed property.

25 II. And be it enacted, That in all and every suit or suits in law or equity, which may hereafter be instituted against the said Corporation, service of process at the resi-
 30 dence of the President, or of the Secretary for the time being, shall be sufficient to compel the said Corporation to appear and plead to such suit or suits, and in case no appear-
 35 ance is made to the said suit or suits, service of all subsequent proceedings in such suit or suits shall be made either personally on the President, or the Secretary for the time being, or at the residence or place of business of one or other of the same Officers; any law, custom or usage to the contrary in any-
 40 wise notwithstanding.

III. And be it enacted, That for the man-
 45 agement of the affairs of the said Corporation, there shall be elected by the Honorary and Ordinary Members of the said Corporation,
