 26 custody of the original, be entered by the
 28 Prothonotaries and Clerks of the Superior
 30 Court, or of the Circuit Court, in the Regis-
 32 ters of the said Courts respectively, and
 34 shall then have full force and effect in each
 36 District or Circuit in which they shall have
 38 been so registered, until they shall have
 40 been repealed or amended, as hereinafter
 42 mentioned, and such repeal or amendment
 44 shall have been registered as aforesaid; and
 46 the Judges of the Superior Court or any six
 48 or more of them shall have full power and
 authority from time to time to repeal or
 amend the said Tariffs and Rules of Practice,
 or any part thereof; and such repeal or
 amendment being signed by any six or more
 of the said Judges shall be registered as afore-
 said by the proper Prothonotaries or Clerks,
 and shall have effect accordingly: Provided
 always, that no such Rule of Practice shall
 be contrary to or inconsistent with this Act,
 or any other Act or law in force in Lower
 Canada, otherwise the same shall be void;
 and provided also, that until such Tariffs of
 Fees and Rules of Practice, respectively,
 shall be made and established as aforesaid,
 the Tariff of Fees and Rules of Practice in
 force in each District or Circuit, immedi-
 ately before the time when this Act shall
 come fully into effect, with regard to the
 Court of Queen's Bench or Circuit Court
 therein, shall continue to be in force, and
 shall apply to the Superior Court or Cir-
 cuit Court and the proceedings therein, as
 far as regards such Districts or Circuit;
