Referring to previous correspondence on the subject of Your claim for services in obtaining particulars relative to the St. Regis Indian Lands in Quebec I have to state, that having taken into consideration

consideration Mr. Branchard's last letter I am of opinion that strictly speaking, You cannot legally claim more than One hundred dollars (\$100) but as You have gone into a much more minute work than was expected of You, and as the work in that direction may be useful in the settlement of claims, I have recommended that One hundred and fifty dollars (\$150) more be granted making Two hundred and fifty dollars \$250. in all for Your combined services, in full of all demands -
