

The minister of the Interior shall be superintendent
- Genl of Indian Affairs

By Act 1887. There shall be a department of Trade
and Commerce, presided over by a minister. Then
the departments of Inland Revenue & Customs
respectively are to be placed under the control
and supervision of the minister in question
(or of finance minister as gov. directs). The Gov-
in-council may also appoint a controller
of Customs and a controller of Inland Revenue,
each of whom shall under the general
instructions of the minister first named
be the principal head of these departments.

is established in this dept. Has direction

The Indian dept. The minister of the Interior
is called Supt-General of Indian Affairs.
He has jurisdiction over Indians to
extent of Indian Act (43 vic 28, 46 vic 6)

was a minister of Inland Rev. it is
now a subordinate department of
Minister of Commerce as is also
the dept of Customs. The duties
of ministers of Commerce are very vague

The minister at the head - the Controller
of Customs - is not a member of the
Cabinet - there is a Commissioner
