MR. KING:

Mr. Roland Beauchamp, (Queen 2105) came in to ask if he might be considered when the question of a sculptor for the monument of Sir Arthur Doughty is being discussed. He is a local sculptor, and left with me the attached photograph of his Bust of the Right Honourable Ernest Lapointe.

Mr. Beauchamp also wondered if you would care to have him do your Bust. He said he could do it while you were working at your desk, and that this was the way in which he had done the Bust of Mr. Lapointe.
