
Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 1st instant, and have to say that the Department is prepared to make you a further advance of \$450. It is, however, necessary that you should first account for the advances already made you; that is to say, you should send receipted pay rolls and vouchers, and send a statement including these, and you own time in account form. All these matters are required in careful detail, in order that they may be readily audited.

It has been decided to increase the rate per day for yourself from \$6. to \$8., in accordance with your request. That is to say the rate of \$6. per day is to be changed up to the end of last month. From the 1st instant you may charge at the rate of \$8. per day.

It is hoped that you will prosecute this survey as rapidly as possible.
