The Prime Minister:

Mr. Measures has telephoned to say that Sir Shuldham Redfern is quite sure that Colonel the Hon. J.J. Astor is coming alone to Ottawa. Mr. Measures says that the report given to him by Senator R. Davies is wrong, and that Lady Astor is not expected at Government House.
