- (b) Colonel R.J. Manion has commenced an inspection of Auxiliary Services facilities in Camps, Barracks and Stations across Canada.
- (c) Since the inception of the swimming programme on July 16th, over 11,000 swimmers have used the outside pool at Camp Borden. Of these, over 3,200 have received class instruction and individual instruction has been given to many others. A one-week's course in life saving and swimming has been held. Over thirty candidates for swimming proficiency certificates attended this course.
- (d) Four tennis courts are under construction at Patricia Bay Air Training Station. Two football fields have also been laid out and an extensive programme of sports has been arranged.
- (e) Orchestras are being formed at many of the isolated Air Stations on the Pacific Coast. These will materially assist in providing entertainment during the winter months.
- (f) A new recreation centre has been opened by the Y.M.C.A. at 66 Slater Street, Ottawa.
- (g) In M.D. No. 2, Citizen Committees have been set up to assist in the employment of men discharged from the Army. Nearly all employable men have been placed.
