Third Witness - B 132688 Pte. Tremblay, J.M., 1st Cdn. Para. Bn., having been duly sworn, states -

> On the night of the 19th of August, 1943, I was at the dance hall at Amesbury. I saw a fight in which Ptes. LEE and LANTHIER were involved. I cannot tell you who they were fighting with. I went ever to try and stop the fight but could not. LEE had a headlock on one chap and I saw Lanthier strike that same person. The fight only lasted about half a minute. Question - Did you see Pte PAISLEY?

Answer - Only when I first went into the dance hall. Question - Was there much of a crowd watching the fight? Answer - Only a few soldiers.

The accused, B 73840 Pte. LEE, M.N. declines to cross-examine this witness.
