With reference to your letter of September 20th, regarding the area and Lot number of the original plan, covering the parcel of land outlined in red on accompanying sketch, and shown as registered in the name of the Methodist Church,

I beg to say that the Land Registry Office inform me the Lot in question originally consisted of 33.9 acres, but it has subsequently been sub-divided into so many different Lots, that they cannot undertake to determine the area remaining in the portion shown under the name of the Methodist Church. This information, they say, would have to be obtained from a Land Surveyor.

Originally, the Lot covered, in addition to the portion marked in red upon the plan, the 8.178 acres, (Sketch 4879), and all the Lots, from No. 1, to No. 21, with adjacent Road Allowances.

The original Sketch No. is 861, and the reference number is 7-422-42582 F.

I am returning the Sketch herewith.
