Dear Sir:

I beg to return herewith your memorandum of account just received. During the past two or three months you have included an item of 1.40 as "arrears", although it has been repeatedly repudiated and explanations gone into. Your contention was that this was a charge for a conversation in June by Miss Peddle, although for several months thereafter it was not brought forward, and meanwhile Miss Peddle ceased to have any work in this office. Miss Peddle asserts that she owes nothing, and the matter being taken up with your officials last month the item was struck out and a bill rendered for \$15.00 in full, which was paid. It is exceedingly vexatious to see this item for which there is no justification constantly appearing on our bills. Please see that bill is rendered, as it should be, for \$7.50 for December service and cheque will issue.
