The pope has a crown of gold, while Christ was crowned with a garland of thorns. He wants to rule all the Kingdoms of the world, while Christ renounced temporal power. The pope has his feet kissed; Christ had His feet pierced whole He washed the disciples' feet. The pope lives in the most costly residence in the world, Christ had not whereon to lay His head.
