## PHYSICAL TRAINING

Healthful atheltic exercises are encouraged, there being in connection with the school large grounds and athletic field, where cricket, football, hockey, etc., are played; there is also a gymnasium for exercise in bad weather.

At the new grounds excellent swimming and bathing is ufforded. Boys who are not able to swim are taught to do so with safety, the bathing always being supervised by a master.
