THIS IS A REPRINT of the FIRST EDITION, and was originally published at five guineas. It has the portrait as above, the Epistle Dedicatoris to Lord Pembroke by John Heminge and Henry Cordell, two leaves, Verses to the Reader by B. I. [BEN IONSON]. This leaf has leaf has the water-mark of J. Whatman, with the date 1806; this leaf being misplaced, and we prefer to leave it undisturbed. The volume is in SPLENDID CONDITION, this being known as Upcott's Typographical Facsimile.
