" land navigation," without any amendment,"

And then he withdrew.

A Message from the Legislative Council, by the Honourable Mr. Baby,

Mr. Speaker,

The Legislative Council have passed a Bill, intituled, "Act to re"peal and amend certain parts of an Act, passed in the thirty-fourth
year of His Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act for the division of
the Province of Lower Canada, for amending the Judicature thereof,
and for repealing certain Laws therein mentioned," to which they
desire the concurrence of this Honourable House.

And then he withdrew.

On motion of Mr. Young, seconded by Mr. Cuthbert,

The faid engroffed Bill was read for the first time, and

Ordered that the same be read a second time on Tuesday the first day of April next.

And then on motion of Mr. Lees, seconded by Mr. Berthelot,
