Mr. Speaker,

The Legislative Council have passed a Bill, intituled, “ Act to re-
 “ peal and amend certain parts of an Act, passed in the thirty-fourth
 “ year of His Majesty’s reign, intituled, “ An Act for the division of
 “ the Province of *Lower Canada*, for amending the Judicature thereof,
 “ and for repealing certain Laws therein mentioned,” to which they
 desire the concurrence of this Honourable House.
