KRASSIN MISSION

STILL A MYSTERY

Speculation is rife regarding the amount of success which the Russian Envoy has met with.

London, June 2.—While the secrecy which has surrounded the mission to London of Gregory Krassin, Russian Bolshevik Minister of Trade and Commerce, is being maintained, several newspapers here print reports on the progress the Soviet envoy is making. It is generally accepted he has received official permission to establish a Russian trade bureau in this city. Some papers go further and declare he has secured a lease on premises in London, but where these are has not been revealed.

This bureau will work in co-operation with the Board of Overseas Trade, a department linking the Board of Trade with the Foreign Office, according to The Daily Mail, but other reports in connection with the mission indicate that the bureau's dealings will be based on virtually a system of barter, Russian grain, oil, timber and flax being offered for railroad rolling stock, agricultural machinery, textiles and other commodities much needed in Russia.
