### WIRELESS FOR EDMONTON?

Edmonton may be the site of an inland wireless telegraph station in connection with a general wireless system established throughout Canada. This morning Secretary A. G. Harrison, of the Board of Trade, received a communication from G. Marconi, inventor of the wireless telegraph system, to the effect that he might be in Edmonton shortly and would look into the question of the establishment of a wireless telegraph station here as part of a general system throughout the interior of the continent.

The letter from Mr. Marconi, which was in reply to an inquiry from the secretary of the Board of Trade regarding the possibility of the system being introduced into this part of Canada, reads in part as follows:

"I hope that within the near future we shall be able to arrange for the more extensive development of our wireless system here, and that it will be in operation in the near future."
