PUBLIC NOTICE. Every person liable to Income Tax shall on or before the thirtieth day of April in each year, without any notice or demand, and any person, whether liable to taxation hereunder or not, upon receipt of a notice or demand in writing from the Commissioner of Taxation, deliver to the Minister a return on oath of his total income during the last preceding year.

Every person who is required to make a return under this Section, whether liable to taxation or not, and who fails to make such return within the time limited therefore, shall be subject on summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding ten dollars for each day during which the default continues.
