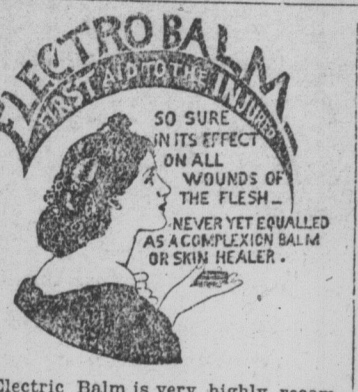

Capacity of a Cow.

Development of Milk Producing Qualities Begins With the Calf. To give a cow a cow must eat and get a great deal and have the internal machinery to take care of what she eats, writes E. L. Vincent in the National Stockman. You take a cow always as milk, do the best you can with her. She is made, so far as her work is concerned, and little can be done to increase her powers in this direction.

Horse Lore.

To groom the horse well after hard work does not only clean the skin, but it prevents various parasitic diseases of the skin. In the purchase of a new horse always purchase a mare. She will raise you some colts, which will increase the farm profits. There is no kind of animal breeding that will pay better than the breeding of horses, but horses that will sell, not dung-hills or misfits. Don't keep your horse in an overheated stable and then stand him for hours in a freezing atmosphere and wonder how he became paralyzed.

Build Silos Round.

The silo should be round and never square. It should be located near the stalls, but shut off from them to keep odors out of the stalls. A roof is not absolutely necessary, but it is better. NOVA SCOTIA FARM HOUSE BURNS; INMATES HAVE A CLOSE CALL. Chester, N. S., March 8.—The home of Melvin Evans at Robinson's Corner, about two miles from here, was totally destroyed by fire this morning. Mr. Evans built a fire in the kitchen at five o'clock and then went to the barn to milk. Only a short time afterwards one of the children, in a nightdress, ran to the barn and told of the house being on fire. Mrs. Evans and the children had to get out in their nightclothes and not a particle of clothing or food was saved. The loss is about \$1,200 with no insurance.
