

Prospecting Licenses up to 100 areas (each 150 feet by 250 feet), issued at 50 cts an area up to 10 areas, and 25cts, afterwards er area, good for one year. These Licenses an area up to 10 areas, and 2:30ts. afterwards er area, good for one year. These Licenses can be selected for second year, by payment of one-half above amount.

I EASES for 20 years t. work and mine. on payment of \$2 an area of 150 feet by 250 feet. Renewable annually at 50 cts. an area in advance.

MINES, OTHER THAN, SOLD AND SILVER.

MINES, OTHER THAN GOLD AND SHAVES.

LICENSES TO SEARCH, good for one year, \$20 for 5 square miles. Lands applied for must not be more than 2½ miles long, and the tract so selected may be surveyed on the Surveyor Generals order at expense of Licensee, if exact bounds cannot be established on maps in Crown Land Cflice. Renewals for second year may be made by consent of Surveyor General, on payment of \$20.

Second Rights to Search can be given over same ground, subject to party holding first Rights, on payment of \$20.

LICENSE TO WORK.—On payment of \$50 for one square mile, good for two years, and extended to three years by further payment of \$25. The lands selected must be surveyed and returned to Crown Land Office.

LEASES are given for 20 years, and renewable to \$0 years, at annual rental of \$50 for 1 square mile. The Surveyor General, if special circumstances warrant, may grant a Lease larger than one equare mile, but not larger than two square miles.
