Appointment of Central Board of Health, S. 12.
From time to time, after the issuins of any such proclamation, (respecting epidemics, \&e.) and wh list it is in force, the LieutenantGovernor may, by commission moler his laand and seal, appoint five or more persons, to be "The Central Porirl of Lealth," and also such officers and servants as he derna necessary to assist the Board; and the powers and cluties of the sand Board may be exercised and executed by any three members thereof : and during any vacancy in the said Board, the continning members or member may act as if no vacancy had occurred. :36 V. c. is. s. 11.
