VISIT TO CANADA OF SIX GRADUATES OF THE NATIONAL SCHOOL OF ADMINISTRATION OF PARIS (ENA)

Six graduates of the Ecole Nationale d'Administration f Paris (ENA) will visit Canada from August 7 to September 18, 965. They will be guests of the Government of Canada from agust 28 to September 18 and of the Government of the Province f Quebec from August 7 to 27.

In 1964, the Government of the French Republic offered train each year at the ENA a number of Canadian civil servants. In the same year two federal civil servants and eight civil ervants of the province of Quebec were chosen for a one-year eriod of instruction at the ENA. This year, ten other Canadian evil servants, selected from Ottawa and Quebec in the same proportion as in 1964, are undergoing a similar period of training.

The Ecole Nationale d'Administration is an institution or recruiting and training those who will eventually constitute the directing and managing staff of the main organs of the French overnment.

This summer's visit will offer an opportunity to a few rench graduates to become familiar with the theory and practice the Canadian public service. The programme of the visit of these aduates in Ottawa will include lectures on political and adnistrative institutions in Canada as well as repor's on the conomic and social situation in Canada. The ENA graduates will so be shown local governmental projects and some cultural aspects Canadian life.
