the names of all persons employed in each month, with the rates of wages, and the number of days for which each man was paid monthly; copies of all accounts of money paid for food and other necessaries; for transplanting men and materials, and for all other expenses connected with the surveys; with the names of persons authorised to purchase or contract for the same; and of those to whom payments were made; also copies of all reports or documents submitted to the Chief Engineer, when called on to report on the comparative merits of the two lines; and a copy of his report.
