

isdiction of their Rebekah Lodge to the territorial jurisdiction of another Rebekah Lodge, or who may be transferred from the territorial jurisdiction of one Rebekah Lodge to another by a change of territorial jurisdiction in which they shall reside, and who shall be in possession of an official certificate or visiting card showing their dues paid not less than four weeks in advance of the date of the application for membership, and who shall desire to unite with the Rebekah Lodge at the place of their new residence, may do so by making application in regular form, accompanied by their official certificate or visiting card and a fee of 25 cents. If elected to membership, the Secretary of the Rebekah Lodge shall immediately send notice of such election together with the fee of 25 cents to the Rebekah Lodge issuing the official certificate or visiting card and request such lodge to issue a transfer certificate for the member. The Rebekah Lodge upon receiving such request and fee, shall, unless charges be pending against such member, issue such transfer certificate without ballot and send at once to the Secretary of the Rebekah Lodge making such request.

Upon the receipt of such transfer certificate the member shall be entitled to sign the Con-
