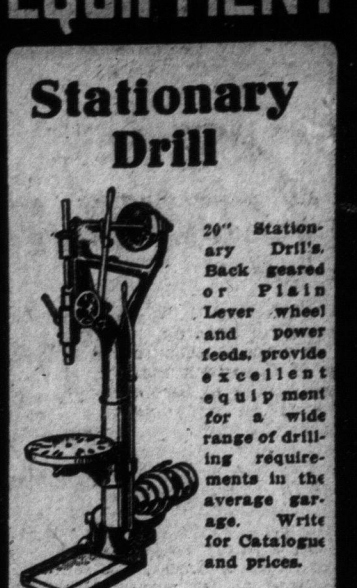

LIVE STOCK MARKET

With receipts of more than 3000 cattle at the Union Stock Yards yesterday there was one of the strongest markets of the season, prices for choice heavy cattle attaining a new high record. There was a strong demand for all classes of cattle, showing weight and quality, at from 10c to 16c per cwt. higher than last week's best prices. The bull market was steady and there was a good demand for milkers and springers, a ready sale for breeders' stock and feeders, with the market well cleaned up. Sheep—There was a strong market for good sheep at from 15c to 16c; medium sheep, 12c to 15c; and common, 10c to 12c.

Special Market Notes.
 A feature of the live stock market yesterday was the sale of one load of steers, 19 in the bunch, fed and consigned by John Cameron and Sons, of the Toronto market, by Rice & Whaley to the Harris Abattoir Co. at \$14.75 per cwt. The highest price for a lot of steers, other than show cattle, at \$14.75 per cwt. The cattle were uniformly high-class and reflected credit on all concerned.

Another Good Sale.
 The Corbett, Hall & Coughlin Co. sold 19 steers, consigned by James Cregar of Shakespeare, and sold to the Swift Canadian at \$14.50 per cwt. They weighed all sold 23,800 lbs.
