### Mason Logan Struck Down Body Placed Across Tracks

Young Man Held Up Near Chippawa by Footpads Who Took \$23 and Left Him Unconscious For the Trolley to Finish -Saved by Wideawake Motorman.

Niagara Falls, Oct. 20.—Another outrage has been committed near Chippewa, this time on the lonely road leading on to the Dufferin Island Bridge, on the upper river in the southern limits of Queen Victoria Park. About 6.45 this evening as Mason Logan, a young man about 23 years of age, living on the hill above the burning springs, and employed in the Carbide Works at Niagara Falls, N.Y., was refurning home on his bicycle, he was struck down by a man with some heavy weapon, knocked completely unconscious and robbed of \$23.

His body was afterwards placed on the rails of the Niagara Falls Park and River Railway. As the 7.20 car from Chippewa, en charge of Conductor Moyer, came along, Motorman McNally noticed from the headlight of his car the body of a man lying across the rails. He stopped the car, and with the conductor, found Logan cold on the rails, and apparently dead, with his blcycle along side him.
