

SLIGHT DECREASE
IN CRIME
IN PAST YEARTwenty More Criminal Cases
Than in 1919FINES TOTAL \$46,095.96
Non-Indictable Offences Num-
ber 3,572.

Despite the fact that a crime wave has been sweeping this continent for months, it affected London but little up to the end of 1920, according to figures compiled today by John Moule, clerk of the police court. In the year 1920 there was an increase of only 20 in the number of criminal cases tried in the local police court, compared with the number of similar cases tried in 1919. During the past year 185 persons were arraigned on criminal charges, while in 1919 there were 165.

In the non-indictable cases, however, there was a considerable increase, for while in 1919 there were but 5,094 cases tried in the court, there was a total of 5,572 during 1920, an increase of 478. The large increase in the number of non-indictable cases was due to greater stringency in enforcing the motor vehicle act and the O.T.A. infringements of all city bylaws and provincial statutes outside of criminal offences. They include offences against the O. T. A., motor vehicle act, and all other minor offences.

That there was little substance to the cry that the children of the city were going astray because there was a juvenile court, was proven by the fact that the juvenile crime of the city showed a decrease of 41 in the number of cases. In 1920 there were 277 children brought before the magistrate, while in 1919 313 children not yet 16 years of age, were tried for various offences.

An increase of \$18,000 in fines was paid into the court during 1920, compared to the amount paid in 1919. A total of \$46,095.96 was paid into the coffers of the police court. Of this amount \$34,995.66 was paid into the city treasury, the balance of \$11,100.30 was turned over to the Provincial Government.

CONFERENCE OF LEAGUE
MEMBERS IS CALLED TO
MEET AT BARCELONA

Paris, Jan. 6.—Sir Eric Drummond, secretary-general of the League of Nations, has called a conference on communication and transport to be held at Barcelona, Spain, late in February. This meeting will be held in accordance with the decision of the assembly of the league at its recent meeting at Geneva and all members of the organization will be asked to participate. Actual conditions regarding transportation will be examined and the project of a statute to improve means of improving the situation which prevails at present. In addition, an international agreement governing the freedom of transit on navigable rivers and railways will be presented, and the project of a statute governing ports will be framed, it is said.

SEVEN KILLED WHEN
POLICE FIRE VOLLEY

Berlin, Jan. 5.—Seven persons were killed and 22 wounded at Paderborn, following a police fire on riotous communists following the funeral of a communist named Hoffman, who was shot by the police when he attempted to escape. In the evening following the funeral a mob attempted to storm the police barracks. Several shots were fired over their heads as a warning, but when the mob continued to advance, the police fired. Forty-two arrests were made, including a number of the communist party.

FRANCE HAS COAL
SURPLUS AT PRESENT

Paris, Jan. 5.—France has a surplus of coal large enough to supply the economic and domestic needs for the next six months, it was stated today by both governmental and commercial officials. Contracts with coal companies in the United States for more than \$100,000,000 worth of coal have been canceled, these authorities said, while the price of French coal has fallen from \$32 a ton to \$12.50 a ton within the last two months.
