#### ELK LAKE DISCOVERY

The machinery at the Elk Lake Discovery Mine is some of the best that has been brought into the silverland of northern Ontario, and the work of erection has been done in a creditable manner. The plant consists of one five-drill Rand compressor, three rock drills, one compressor tank, two wood-burning 60 H.P. boilers, one two-ton steam hoist, a small steam pump for supplying the boilers and compressor with water, and a fully equipped
