A short time after the formation of this Society, a supply of Books was received from the Montreal District Committee—most of which were soon disposed of, as well as a number of Prayer Books, which were, in like manner received from York.

On the 20th Oct. last, the “Niagara Bible Society,” at a publick meeting, passed the following resolution:—

“At a General Meeting of the Niagara Bible Society, held at the Episcopal Church, this 20th day of October, 1826, the Rev. ROBT ADDISON being called to the chair, it was

“*Resolved*, That in consequence of this Society wanting sufficient support, it merges into the Niagara District Society for Promoting Christian Knowledge, and called the “*Niagara District Committee*”—and that all the Members of this Society who wish to become Members of the above, shall be entitled to all the privileges of the Members, and also, to credit for the amount paid by them respectively, as subscribers to the Bible Society.”

The above resolution was submitted to the Standing Committee, at their next Quarterly Meeting, held on the 9th Jan. last, and it was resolved, “That in consequence of this resolution of the Niagara Bible Society, all Members thereof shall be considered Mem-
