Sir,-

I have to inform you that the receipt (through the Indian Commissioner on the 11th. of February) of the pay-lists for the distribution to Thunderchild's Band and also your letter of February 8th arrived just as the Department was about to take serious notice of your laches in this matter, and action was stayed. I must point out that your explanations are not considered satisfactory, and that, in future, in dealing with official matters and particularly with matters of such importance as those under discussion, you should act with promptitude. I must draw your attention also to the fact that, as you were informed on the 11th. of January, you still held money which should long ago have been forwarded to the Department, and to inform you that all matters in arrears in your office must be immediately despatched.
