Halibut, cod, haddock, salmon, sea trout, sea tbass, flounders and other salt-water fish are sold in Toronto, and the demand is slowly growing. One firm told the Globe that in five years their trade had grown from 500 pounds a week to 3,0000 pounds a week of sea fish.
"If you could only persuade people that salt-water fish are just as good as lake fish, and in fact better, the demand would grow papidly. Sea fish have a finer flavor than then reshipped to Toronto and landed cheaper here, after paying half a cent a pound duty besides, than they can b brought direct to Toronto by express in apidly.
